## 3-D Chihuahua Dog



## What you need:

1) Glass seed beads size $11 / 0$ (black, brown \& white)
2) Beading string ( 0.25 mm )

## Always Remember to pull tight on EVERY STEP.

The pictorials are illustrated with spaces between beads for a clearer direction, in the actual beading, there should be no spaces.

## STEP 1:

Cut a piece of beading string around $11 / 2$ meter long.
The Head
Add five white beads at the exact center of the string.
Crisscross the other end of the string through the last bead added (shown where the two arrows crisscrosses and comes out from).

## STEP 2:

Add two brown beads and one white bead on the right (red) string, crisscross the left (black) string through the last bead added (shown where the black arrow is coming out from).


## STEP 3:

Add four white beads on the right (black) string, crisscross the left (red) string through the last added bead. Continue to pass the black string (the one you just used to add new beads on) through the bottom white bead from step 1 (marked with A).


## STEP 4:

Add two brown beads on the top (red) string, crisscross the bottom (black) string through the last added bead. Continue to pass the red string (the one you just used to add new beads on) through the bottom white bead from step 1 (marked with A).


## STEP 5:

Add three brown beads on the top (black) string, crisscross the bottom (red) string through the last added bead. Continue to pass the black string (the one you just used to add new beads on) through the white bead from step 1. (marked with A).


## STEP 6:

Add four brown beads on the right (red) string, crisscross the left (black) string through the last added bead. Continue to pass the red string (the one you just used to add new beads on) through the top two beads from step1 and 2 (marked with A and B).

## STEP 7:

Add two brown beads on the bottom (black) string, crisscross the top (red) string through the last added bead.


## STEP 8:

Add four brown beads on the bottom (red) string, crisscross the top (black) string through the last added bead. Continue to pass the red string (the one you used to add new beads on) through the top two beads from step 2 and 3 (marked with A and B).


## STEP 9:

Add one brown bead and one white bead on the right (black) string, crisscross the left (red) string through the last added bead.


## STEP 10:

EYE: Add one black bead on the left (red) string, pass this same string through one brown and one white beads and back up the exact same white bead that the string started out from (shown where the red arrow is coming out of).
Continue to pass the right black string through the right white bead (shown where the black arrow is coming out of)


## STEP 11:

Add four white beads on the left (red) string, crisscross the right (black) string through the last added bead. Continue to pass the red string (the one you used to add new beads on) through the bottom two beads (marked with A and B).


## STEP 12:

Add two brown beads on the top (black) string, crisscross the bottom (red) string through the last added bead.


## STEP 13:

EYE: Add one black bead on the left (black) string, pass the same string back through the beads shown marked A, B, C and D.


## STEP 14:

Add three brown beads on the top (red) string, crisscross the bottom (black) string through the last added bead. Continue to pass the red string (the one you used to add new beads on) through the bottom two beads (marked with $\mathbf{A}$ and $\mathbf{B}$ ).


## STEP 15:

Add two brown beads on the top right (black) string, crisscross the bottom left (red) string through the last added bead. Continue to pass the black string (the one you used to add new beads on) through the left brown bead (marked with A).


## STEP 16:

Add four brown beads on the right (red) string, crisscross the right (black) string through the last added bead. Continue to pass the red string (the one you used to add new beads on) through the three left beads (marked with A, B and C).


## STEP 17:

Add one brown bead on the right (black) string, crisscross the right (red) string through the last added bead. Continue to pass the black string (the one you used to add new bead on) through the top left bead (marked with $\mathbf{A}$ ). Continue to pass the red string through the bottom right bead (marked with A).


## STEP 18:

Add two brown beads on the bottom (red) string, crisscross the top (black) string through the last added bead. Continue to pass the red string (the one you used to add new beads on) through the three top beads (Marked A, B and C).


## STEP 19:

Add one brown bead on the bottom (black) string, crisscross the top (red) string through the last added bead. Continue to pass the black string (the one you used to add new beads on) through the top bead (Marked A). Continue to pass the other string (red) through the bottom two beads (Marked A and B).


## STEP 20:

Add two brown beads on the bottom (red) string, crisscross the top (black) string through the last added bead. Continue to pass the red string (the one you used to add new beads on) through the three top beads (Marked A, B and C).


## STEP 21:

Add one brown bead on the right (black) string, crisscross the left (red) string through the last added bead.


## STEP 22:

To pass the top right red string through the four brown beads (Marked A, B, C and D) and pass the bottom left black string through the one bead marked D.
Now you should have a round ball shape head with two eyes (nose will be added on later).


Before you continue to the body of the Chihuahua, look at this picture to the right: the $\mathbf{6}$ bead circle you see is from the bottom of the dog's head that you have completed and it's also where you will be continue to bead and attach the body from. The red dot is where both your threads are crisscrossed at right now - where you left off from step 22.


## STEP 23:

Add four brown beads on the top (red) string, crisscross the bottom (black) string through the last added bead. Continue to pass the red string (the one you used to add new beads on) through the one brown bead from the head (Marked A).


## STEP 24:

Add four brown beads on the right (black) string, crisscross the left (red) string through the last added bead. Continue to pass the black string (the one you used to add new beads on) through the one top bead (Marked A).


## STEP 25:

Add three brown beads on the bottom (red) string, crisscross the top (black) string through the last added bead. Continue to pass the red string (the one you used to add new beads on) through top brown bead (Marked A).


## STEP 26:

Add two brown beads and one white bead on the bottom left (black) string, crisscross the top right (red) string through the last added bead. Continue to pass the black string (the one you used to add new beads on) through the one top bead (Marked A).


## STEP 27:

Add three white beads on the left (red) string, crisscross the right (black) string through the last added bead. Continue to pass the red string (the one you used to add new beads on) through two brown beads (Marked A and $\mathbf{B}$ ).


## STEP 28:

Add two brown beads on the top (black) string, crisscross the bottom (red) string through the last added bead. Continue to pass the black string (the one you used to add new beads on) through the one bottom bead (Marked A).


## STEP 29:

Add four brown beads on the top (red) string, crisscross the bottom (black) string through the last added bead. Continue to pass the red string (the one you used to add new beads on) through two brown beads (Marked A and B).

## STEP 30:



Add two brown beads on the right (black) string, crisscross the left (red) string through the last added bead. Continue to pass the black string (the one you used to add new beads on) through the one bottom bead (Marked A).


## STEP 31:

TAIL: Add two brown beads on the left (black) string, pass the string back through the first bead added and further back through the bead where you started off with (shown where the black arrow is coming out of).


## STEP 32:

Add three brown beads on the right (red) string and crisscross the left (black) string through the last added bead.
Continue to pass the red string (the one you used to add new beads on) through the two brown beads (Marked A and B).

## STEP 33:

Add two brown beads on the bottom right (black) string and crisscross the top left (red) string through the last added bead. Continue to pass the black string (the one you used to add new beads on) through the top two brown beads (Marked A and B).


## STEP 34:

Add three brown beads on the bottom (red) string and crisscross the top (black) string through the last added bead.
Continue to pass the red string (the one you used to add new beads on) through the two beads (Marked A and B).


## STEP 35:

Add two white beads on the bottom left (black) string and crisscross the top right (red) string through the last added bead. Continue to pass the black string (the one you used to add new beads on) through the three beads (Marked A, B and C).


## STEP 36:

Add one white bead on the top left (red) string and crisscross the bottom right (black) string through the last added bead.
Continue to pass the red string (the one you used to add new beads on) through the bead (Marked A).
Continue to pass the black string through the two beads (Marked A and B).


A switch of view: from this point on the bead's view will be changed to inwards. Note that the marks of the red and blue A and $B$ are exactly the same location of the above step 36 .


## STEP 37:

Add two white beads on the left (black) string, crisscross the right (red) string through the last added bead. Continue to pass the black string (the one you used to add new beads on) through the brown beads (Marked A, B and C).


## STEP 38:

Add one white bead on the top (red) string, crisscross the bottom (black) string through the last added bead. Continue to pass the red string (the one you used to add new beads on) through the beads (Marked A, B, C, D and $\mathbf{E}$ ). Note: $\mathbf{E}$ is the bead that you just added on this step.
You have now completed the body of the dog (attached to the head). It may look a bit weird right now but be patient, once the nose and legs goes on, it'll be perfect.


Position of the legs: The Four red circular lines are the positions where the four legs will go on, the turquoise color dots are where the legs beading will start on (the same spot for the two front legs and the same spot for the two back legs.
Your threads are currently at the back leg's start spot (turquoise spot). So you can continue to bead the back leg with the existing lines.


## STEP 39:

Pass the top (black) line up through the white bead (Marked 1). Add three brown beads on the bottom (red) string, crisscross the top (black) string through the last added bead. Continue to pass the red string down a brown bead (Marked A).


## STEP 40:

Add two brown beads on the top (black) string and crisscross the bottom (red) string through the last added bead. Continue to pass the black string (the one you used to add new beads on) through the bottom bead (Marked A).


## STEP 41:

Add two brown beads on the right (red) string and crisscross the left (black) string through the last added bead. Continue to pass the red string (the one you used to add new beads on) through the two left beads (Marked A and B).


## STEP 42:

Add one brown bead on the right (black) string and crisscross the left (red) string through the last added bead.


## STEP 43:

Add three brown beads on the right (red) string and crisscross the left (black) string through the last added bead. Continue to pass the red string (the one you used to add new beads on) through the top bead (Marked A).

## STEP 44:

Add two brown beads on the bottom (black) string and crisscross the top (red) string through the last added bead. Continue to pass the black string (the one you used to add new beads on) through the bottom bead (Marked A).


## STEP 45:

Add two brown beads on the top (red) string and crisscross the bottom (black) string through the last added bead.
Continue to pass the red string (the one you used to add new beads on) through the two brown beads (Marked $\mathbf{A}$ and $\mathbf{B}$ ).


## STEP 46:

Add one brown bead on the bottom top right (black) string and crisscross the bottom left (red) string through the last added bead. Continue to pass the black string (the one you used to add new beads on) through the top two brown beads (Marked A, B, C and D). Note that D is the new bead added on this step.
Now you can either pass the thread back through the piece to the place where you started off this leg or tie off and pass the thread back a few beads before cutting away excess.


## STEP 47:

Left back leg: Either pass the string to the point of the red dot Continue to: or cut a new piece of string around $1 / 3$ meter long and string it through the point of the red dot (refer to picture on page 3 of the tutorial - between step 38 and 39).

Pass the top (black) line up through the white bead (Marked 1). Add three brown beads on the bottom (red) string, crisscross the top (black) string through the last added bead. Continue to pass the red string down a brown bead (Marked A).
Compare this step to step 39. once you see the similarity, repeat step 40 to step 46 - in similar way but opposite direction of beading.


## STEP 48:

Cut a new piece of string around $1 / 3$ meter long, string it into the bead marked with the red dot. (refer to picture - between step 38 and 39).

Pass the bottom (black) line up through the white bead (Marked 1). Add three brown beads on the top (red) string, crisscross the bottom (black) string through the last added bead. Continue to pass the red string down a brown bead (Marked A).

## Compare this step to step 39. once you see the similarity, repeat step 40 to step 46 - in similar way but opposite direction of beading.



## STEP 49:

Cut a new piece of string around $1 / 3$ meter long, string it into the bead marked with the red dot. (refer to picture - between step 38 and 39).

Pass the bottom (black) line up through the white bead (Marked 1). Add three brown beads on the top (red) string, crisscross the bottom (black) string through the last added bead. Continue to pass the red string down a brown bead (Marked A).

## Compare this step to step 39. once you see the similarity, repeat step 40 to step 46.



Nose or Snout: The red lined white bead circle ring will be where you will be adding the nose. The red dot will be starting point (cut a piece of string around $1 / 3$ meter long, string it through the bead marked with the red dot - balance out both ends).


## STEP 50:

Add two white beads on the bottom right (red) string, crisscross the top left (black) string through the last added bead. Continue to pass the red string (the one you used to add new beads on) through the white bead on top (Marked A).


## STEP 51:

Add two white beads on the bottom (black) string, crisscross the top (red) string through this bead. Continue to pass the black string (the one you used to add new beads on) through the right bead (Marked A).


## STEP 52:

Add one black and one white bead on the left (red) string, crisscross the right (black) string through the last added bead. Continue to pass the red string (the one you used to add new beads on) through the white bottom bead (Marked A).


## STEP 53:

Add two white beads on the top (black) string and crisscross the bottom (red) string through the last added bead. Continue to pass the black string (the one you used to add new beads on) through the bottom bead (Marked A).


## STEP 54:

Add one white bead on the top right (red) string and crisscross the bottom left (black) string through the last added bead. Continue to pass the red string (the one you used to add new beads on) through the two left beads (Marked A and B).


## STEP 55:

Add one white bead on the right (black) string and crisscross the left (red) string through the last added bead.
Continue to pass the red string through the four beads marked A, B, C and $\mathbf{D}$. Note that $\mathbf{D}$ is the new bead added on this step.


## Position of the ears:

The picture shows the top of the dog's head (nose at the bottom).
The two red dots on the left represents where the left ear will go.
The two red dots on the right represents where the right ear will go. Cut a piece of new thread for each ear, around 6 inches each.

## NOSE

## STEP 56:

Left Ear: Pass the new string through the bead marked with the red dot.
Add five brown beads on the bottom left (black) string and crisscross the top right (red) string through the last added bead. Continue to pass the black string (the one you used to add new beads on) through the right bead (Marked A).

## STEP 57:

Add three brown beads on the bottom right (black) string and crisscross the top left (red) string through the last added bead. Continue to pass the black string (the one you used to add new beads on) through the one left bead (Marked A).


## STEP 58:

Add three brown beads on the left (black) string and crisscross the right (red) string through the last added bead. Tie off and pass the string back through a few beads before cutting away excess.


## STEP 59:

Right Ear: Pass the new string through the bead marked with the red dot.

Add five brown beads on the bottom right (black) string and crisscross the top left (red) string through the last added bead. Continue to pass the black string (the one you used to add new beads on) through the right bead (Marked A).
Compare this to step 56, it's the exact same step except in opposite direction. Continue to repeat step 57 and 58 and you are done!
